Mandatory for HBR Membership

This course fulfills NAR's Cycle 6 Code of Ethics requirement due by **December 31, 2020**. The National Association of REALTORS® requires REALTORS® to complete ethics training every two years. The current two-year cycle will end **December 31, 2020**.

Failure to complete training during this cycle will lead to:

- Suspension of membership for January and February 2021
- Termination of membership starting March 1, 2021


The course is designed to enhance the standard of professionalism by addressing pertinent issues that are occurring locally in Hawaii. After completing this course, agents will understand the Code of Ethics, Standards of Practice, and be able to apply these tenets in their professional dealings with clients, the public, and other REALTORS®.

Agents will analyze case studies to identify and resolve ethical issues related to Articles 2, 10 and 12. These articles focus on refraining from concealing pertinent facts, providing equal professional service, and being honest and truthful in communication.

If you became a new member of the Honolulu Board of REALTORS® from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2020 and have completed HBR's New Member Orientation during this period, you have met the NAR Code of Ethics Training requirement. You are still eligible to receive 3 CE elective credits by taking this course.
