Honolulu Board of REALTORS® to postpone classes and upcoming events effective March 16
Social distancing measures being implemented amid COVID-19 concerns

Aloha HBR members,

The well-being of our members, our staff, their families and our community remains our top priority. To keep everyone as safe and healthy as possible, we have decided to make the following changes, **effective Monday, March 16, 2020 through Thursday, April 30, 2020:**

- **All HBR and HiCentral MLS classes and events will be postponed indefinitely.** This includes any training or classes scheduled at member firms. This also includes our **March 20 PB/BIC Roundtable** and our **April 17 Agent Forum**. Cancellation notices will be sent to all members registered for events from 3/16-4/30 and refunds will be processed.
- **All Regional Group meetings and YPN events will also be postponed.**
- **HBR offices will be open for email and phone service only, no walk-in service.**
- **All committee meetings will take place via teleconference or Zoom,** including the HBR and HiCentral MLS Board meetings.

We will reassess the situation and make further determinations as necessary on April 1, including a decision regarding the June GMM. Should the situation improve, we may resume full service sooner.

We are committed to doing all we can to effectively provide the services you expect from the voice of O'ahu's real estate industry. I sincerely appreciate your support and understanding as we all do our part to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and keep our community healthy.
